POTTERIES MUSEUM AND ART GALLERY



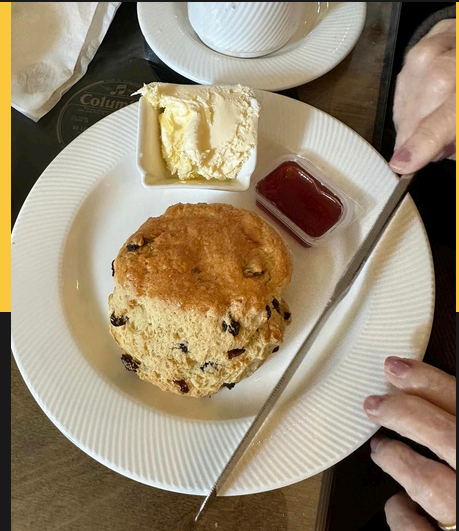
Our visit to the Potteries Museum and Art Gallery was both fun and entertaining for our residents. They thoroughly enjoyed this local excursion.
